

Life Expectancy at Birth - South Asia








Pakistan Ranked 137th Across 139 Countries, 2021







Distribution of Farm Area by Tenure






Tax to GDP Ratio - Selected Countries






The China Model III: District as Residual Claimant

As one of the district's officers described it, "We hope to forge a friendly business environment by providing all-round services, for example, applying for permits, filling out paperwork, coordinating among various departments, parking, schooling, taking care of the surrounding sanitation, and so on. We want to serve businesses well, because every business has a thick network behind it, including friends and business associates. If we serve one investor well, we can access and mobilize these resources and attract more investors, thereby promoting our district's economic development and tax revenue base."25



Defense Spending Differences - India and Pakistan





Putting it all together

- Pakistan has been stagnating relative to peers for at least 4 decades;
- An uneducated youth bulge in the age of automation, and military disparity with India render the status quo untenable;
- Better policing, property registration, and contract enforcement are required;
- Pakistan needs to create autonomous universities, protected from elite capture;
- Sub-provincial level competition, and power to collect and spend taxes is needed.
